

Today is the feast of St. Margaret, Queen of Scotland (1045-1093)

“Above all things else, Margaret taught her husband [Malcolm] how to pray. Seeing that she often spent the night in prayer, he would creep into the dark church after her to share her vigil, shedding tears of bitter sorrow for his sins, so that [others] marveled to see so rough a soldier manifest such deep devotion. So Margaret led her Malcolm to the feet of God. It was no easy victory. Many and bitter were the tears it cost her, long and earnestly she prayed and fasted. Once only did a cloud arise between them, when an evil-minded courtier sought to sow suspicion in his master’s mind. Wherefore did the queen so often retire alone to a secret cave in the forest of Dunfermline? One day Malcolm followed her. As he approached the place he heard her voice raised in tones of earnest entreaty. Seizing his sword, he was about to break in fury through the bushes when her words fell upon his ear: she was storming Heaven for her husband’s soul. Her prayer was quickly answered, as with tears of deep repentance, he threw himself before her feet. “The king and queen were blessed with...six sons and two daughters...this holy queen left her children this instruction: ‘1. To die a thousand deaths rather than commit one mortal sin. 2. To give sovereign honor and absolute adoration to the Most Holy Trinity, and to have particular respect and veneration to the most Blessed Virgin, the Mother of God. 3. To be charitable to the poor, to protect orphans and relieve them in their necessities. 4. To abhor all obscene language and uncleanness. 5. To converse with persons of blameless lives and to follow their judgments and counsels. 6. To be firm, constant and unchangeable in maintenance of the Catholic Faith.’ Such were the lessons St. Margaret taught her children, whom she would often gather round her and ‘carefully instruct them about Christ and the things of Christ as far as their age would permit, and she admonished them to love Him always.’” ~ Cecil Kerr, *St. Margaret Queen of Scotland*, 1930.

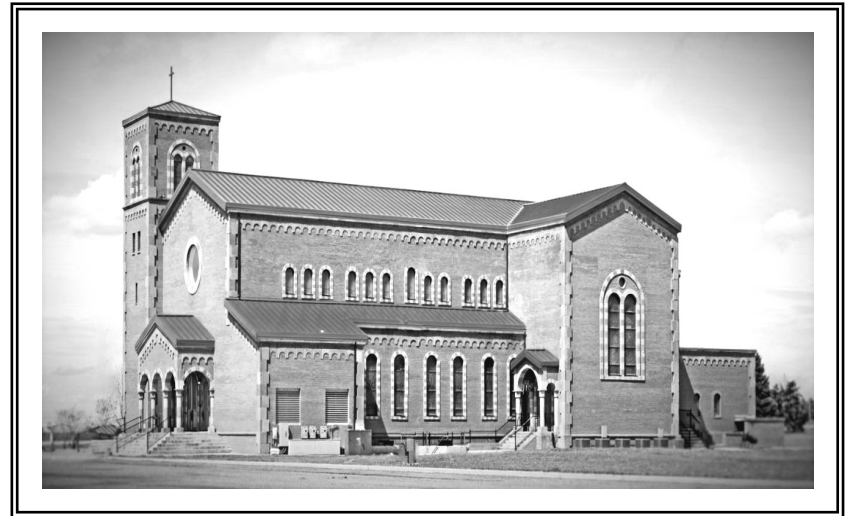
