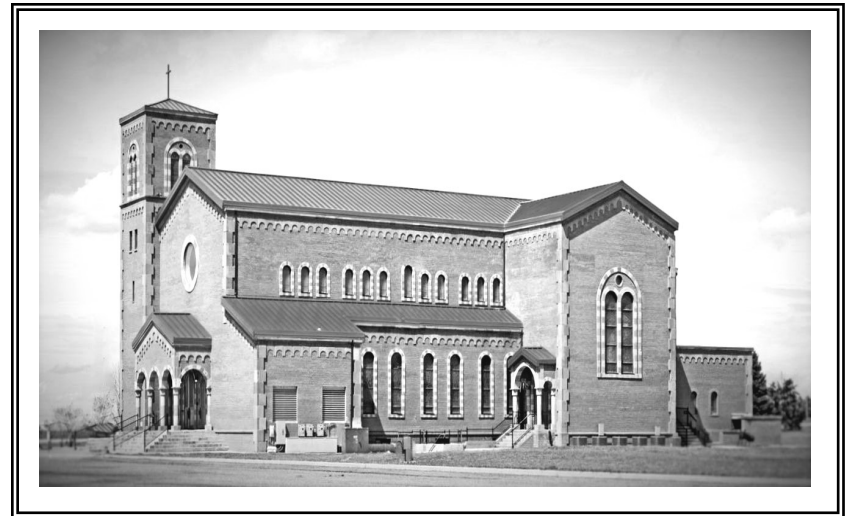

## PARISH ANNOUNCEMENTS

**Traditional Day of Fast and Partial Abstinence:** This Saturday, the Vigil of Pentecost, is traditionally a day on which adults fast (one main meat meal, and two smaller collations) and those aged 7 and older restrict themselves to having meat only once.

**Easter Duty:** Catholics are required to receive Holy Communion during this season — which will end on Trinity Sunday, June 16th. Since, of course, this precept is not fulfilled by a sacrilegious Communion, all are encouraged to receive the holy Sacrament of Penance.

**Altar and Rosary:** No meeting today. Altar and Rosary has only received five recipes so far, and the June 16th deadline is quickly approaching. There is a box in the vestibule to collect recipes, or you can email them to any of the Altar and Rosary ladies.
